What is sustainability management?

Sustainability management applies sustainable practices to businesses, agriculture, facilities, and communities with the goal of lowering emissions and energy use, encouraging growth, and ensuring the availability of resources (and a healthy planet!) for future generations.



What is the concept of sustainability?

Sustainability consists of fulfilling the needs of current generations without compromising the needs of future generations, while ensuring a balance between economic growth, environmental care and social well-being.



What is the importance of sustainability management?

Sustainable management provides plans that can improve multiple parts of people lives, environment, and future generations. If a community sets goals, then people are more likely to reduce energy, water, and waste, but a community cannot set goals unless they have the management in place to set goals.



What are the 3 major components of sustainability management?

Sustainability's three main pillars represent the **environment, social responsibility and the economic**. (These three pillars are also informally referred to as people, planet, purpose and profits.)
